signed the contract for the City's new Juvenile

The building will cost 126 thousand dollars and is
to be built at city-owned Coyner Springs. With Owens
for the signing was architect Randolph Frantz and E. A.
Sexton of the Days Construction Company, low bidder on
the project.

Work is expected to start just as soon as better
weather gets here - possibly 15 days. Completion date
is August 30th. Owens says he doesn't know yet what
the City will do with the old, antiquated detention
home on Rorer Avenue, southwest.
