headquarters, has challenged American youth to revert to an increase in the spiritual values which he says "made America a great nation from its very beginning. Suttler spoke before the 38th Annual Conference of the Virginia State Society of Children of the American Revolution. Suttler listed a lack of incentive to get a proper education, the threat of communism, and a dangerous tendency towards personal non-involvement in good citizenship as trends which must be reversed.
