Roanoke City Council went behind closed doors to discuss implementing the recommendations of the Civic Center

Study Committee and emerged with little comment on any action taken.

Council has passed a resolution authorizing application for Federal Funds available under the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964. ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ The funds would be applied for in conjunction with Roanoke and Botetourt Counties. Any projects undertaken with the "War on Poverty" funds would be directed by the Roanoke Valley Council of Community Services.

Council authorized a total of 106-thousand dollars to proceed with the Franklin Road South widening project. The lions share of the money will go for condemning land needed for the widening. The Funds will come from the 1965 Budget.

Council also set up a committee ~~xxx~~ composed of Councilmen Jones ~~xxxx~~ Garland and City Manager Owens to look into the possibility of giving firemen the same holidays as other city employes receive. Council passed on second reading the authorization for ~~xx~~ eight holidays for Police.
