20 gifted science students will be chosen from Southwest Virginia High Schools before April 13th to participate in a special science program underwritten by the National Science Foundation, administered by the University of Virginia and conducted largely thru the Roanoke School System. The foundation announced the grant yesterday. Dr. A.R. Kuhlthau, Dr. T.G. Williamson, both of the University of Virginia and Dr. David Redfield, Science Coordinator of Roanoke Public Schools met today to organize final details of the program.
