Virginia Parks Commissioner Ben Bolen says a long range development plan for the Carvins Cove Recreation area

will result from his study as requested by Roanoke City Council. Bolen made an unscheduled inspection tour of the Cove this afternoon. He stopped off in Roanoke on his way to a North Carolina convention. Bolen says it is possible the Federal Bureau of Outdoor Recreation may be asked the help in the study. The Commissioner of Parks says ~~his~~ his preliminary tour today convinces him the Cove has good potential for recreation. But, he says, such activities must not interfere with the primary purpose of the Cove as a basic water supply. All recreation at the Cove, according to the Commissioner, should be carefully supervised. He ~~confers~~ ^{CONCURRE} with the Cove Committee's recommendation that new toilet facilities should be constructed at the concession stand and in the picnic area. But final location of a toilet for the Bennett Springs area should be reserved until a complete study has been made, says Bolen. He will return in about 30 days to make a detailed study.
