Governor Harrison says he is opposed to requiring an annual or semi-annual voter (take film) registration as a means of replacing the functions of the poll tax. Harrison reaffirmed his stand that Virginia should keep the poll tax as a ~~re~~ pre-requisite to voting in state and local elections. He also told a news conference yesterday he has no plan to run for the ~~senate~~ U. S. Senate in 1964, and hopes to return to his law practice when his term as governor is over. Last night, the governor addressed the State Conference of the Daughters of the American Revolution, at Hotel Roanoke. Harrison said Virginians, while looking forward to the better things of life, remain dedicated to changeless principals.
