A 60-year-old Pulaski man has been charged with murder following a shooting in Pulaski yesterday afternoon.

He's James Warf, who's charged in the death of 32-year-old Garnett Freeman of Pulaski. According to Police Chief Earl Bouldin, the men--both employes of General Chemical Company--had a long standing quarrel over ~~xxx~~ work.

The two met as they were entering the third street gate to the company grounds. Freeman reportedly jumped on Warf and gave him a beating. It was then that Warf shot Freeman with a .32 caliber pistol. Warf said he carried the weapon for protection going home when he gets off from work at midnight, and used the gun in self defense.
