35-year-old Booker T. King, a former convict who gave his address as the Roanoke City Jail, was arrested by officers after he fled the scene in a cab. King, according to police, was recently released from Bland County Correctional Farm where he was serving time for another shooting.

The wounded man is 27-year-old John Tyree of 1114 Dunbar Avenue, Northwest. The shooting occurred at 107 Loudon Avenue, Northwest. Tyree is shot in the right side.

King is also charged on another warrant with threatening to kill. That warrant was sworn out prior to today's shooting.
