Roanoke City Council has taken under advisement a recommendation that it advertise for bids for construction of the Civic Center on February 28th.

Last week, Council demanded to be handed the architects plans for the Roanoke Civic Center. Yesterday, Associated Architects and Engineers of Roanoke, represented by John Chappellear and Henry Boynton, presented Mayor Dillard with a huge roll of blueprints said to weigh thirty pounds. Council will meet soon with representatives and architects to be briefed on the high points of the plans in layman's language. No design changes are planned. In other business, Council took under advisement a request from C. Harry Anglin to operate a cable television facility. On another matter, the governing body passed a resolution offered by Mayor Dillard to press for a full time Circuit Court Judge for the city. And Council agreed to set a date for a meeting with the County Board of Supervisors, a meeting which may be held soon.
